- III. ACTION ITEMS
  - a) **Neighborhood Restoration Team Back to School Fair**

*The RWS Staff will provide a complete information sheet.* The discussion of the fair centered on date: August 25 – Saturday 9:00 to Noon- cooler weather. Location: both inside and outside options, with power. Vance, Pat Pheiffer, Rockwood Central, PAL, Rockwood Christian Church, Library, RCO were all suggested- finalized at later date. The central idea is to allow people to register through: local org's, schools, & via RCO – use reduced lunch criteria sheet to qualify. Utilize Sunshine Division data base system to reduce duplication. Children come to the fair and pick up BASIC supplies [from priority list provided by schools] those who do not can get supplies at the fair can register and pick up the supplies at their school. All supplies go to RCO for storage and sorting. Go to Office Depot, WALMART, COSTCO –etc for larger supplies that go directly to school: Kleenex, hand sanitizer and classroom needs. Do sponsor sheets, info sheets have all out prior to school release – advertise dates and program through summer lunch sites.
  - b) National Night Out – the group feels that it would be beneficial to pursue a quieter event in the local Rockwood community and utilize what resources Police might be able to make available – GPD is committed to one larger event only.
  - c) Retrospective : Discussion of short celebration / or finale presentation on the Rockwood Weed and Seed project: Opportunity to advocate for the future, celebrate success and provide a vision for the future. Could be taped or have show on MCTV. Enthusiastic response.
